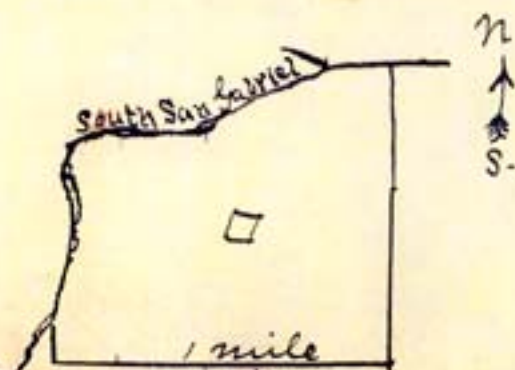


Statement of the Territory and Inhabitants
— of the —
City of Georgetown, Texas.

The following are the field notes of the ~~city~~^{corporate} limits of the
city of Georgetown, Texas, at this date to-wit: February
14th 1894 =

Beginning at a point that is one-half mile due
East from the center of the Court house (as it for-
merly stood); Thence due South one-half mile;
Thence due West one mile to a stake for the South-
West corner of said corporation; Thence due North
to the Middle of the Channel of the South San Gabriel;
Thence down the same with its meanders to a point
that a line due South would strike the place of
beginning — Plat. —



Containing a little less than one square mile.

We consider 3000 a reasonable estimate of the number
of inhabitants within the corporate limits of the
City of Georgetown, Texas — perhaps a few more or a
few less.
